Do you need to file?

The "general rule" is a business owner must issue a Form 1099-MISC or a 1099-NEC (*new this year*) to each person whom you paid at least \$600 in rents, services (including parts and materials) prizes and awards or other income payments.

Exceptions: Do not report payments made to a corporation (including an LLC treated like a C or S corporation). The exception to this is that you always report payments to an attorney, whether or not they are a corporation.

Although it may seem inconsequential, due to the fact that it is an information form, filing the correct 1099 is important. The penalties for not doing so vary from \$30 to \$100 per form. In addition, the IRS indicates that if you did not file a Form 1099, and were required to, it may not allow the deduction for the expense.

Form 1099-MISC vs 1099-NEC

The 1099-NEC is used to report independent contractor type income.

The 1099-MISC is used to report miscellaneous income such as rent or other income.

Form 1099-MISC

The detail for the most common payments, in the course of your business to whom you have paid:

- At least \$10 in Royalties (box 2)
- At least \$600 in:
 - Rents to landlord (box 1) (exception rent through real estate agent)
 - Other Income i.e., Prizes and awards (box 3)
 - Gross Proceeds paid to an attorney, not fees for services, a settlement agreement for example (box 10) (fees for services are now reported on 1099-NEC)
- A checkbox when payer made direct sales of \$5,000 or more of consumer products on a buy-sell, deposit-commission or other than in a permanent retail establishment (box 7))

Form 1099-NEC

Needed for payments of \$600 or more for nonemployee compensation.

- Professional service fees such as accountants, architects, contractors, fee splitting or referral fees, commissions, etc. (box 1)
- Payments made to an attorney for their fees (box 1)

Due Date

The due date for the 1099's to all recipients is due January 31, 2021.
